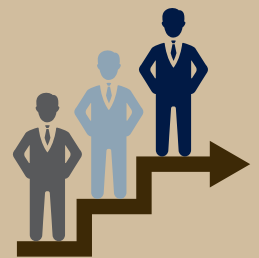
National Institute on Minority Health and
