The Fellow may propose the generation of other products as well. (I am currently creating similar resources for quantitative research.)

o <u>HHS Summer Grant Writing Fellows Program</u> supports faculty in their efforts to submit strong grant proposals. Fellows must identify a mentor, attend a series of summer workshops, and agree to submitting a grant within the following year. Fellows may receive a \$4,000 summer stipend. Upon successful grant submission within a year, they may receive an additional \$1,000 award and their mentors may receive a \$500 award. Applications through InfoReady for summer 2023 are due **February 27, 2023 by 5:00 p.m.**

o <u>Undergraduate Research and Creativity Award (URCA)</u> Funds help faculty and students partner in meaningful projects in their discipline/field of study. Support can be used for material expenses and/or related travel, or can be used to provide a stipend for the students. Students can earn up to \$3,000 (annually) for their work. Faculty can request up to \$500 in support of the project.
